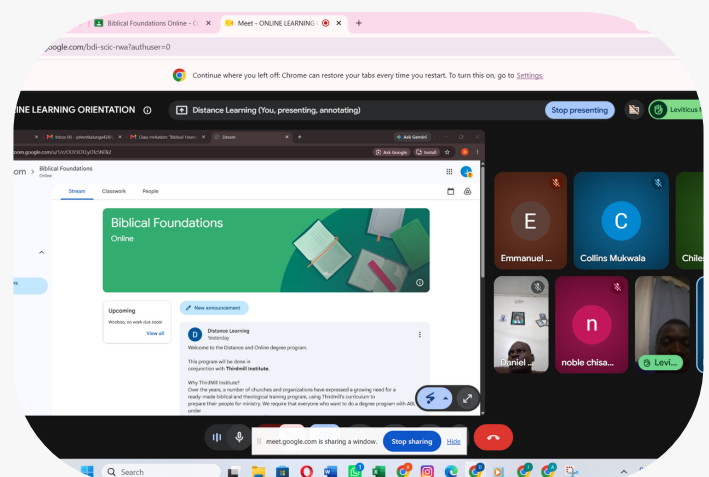
Vision 2030

A word from the Principal

Based on Mark 6:1-6, I would like us to be careful in our theological studies to ensure that, by God's grace, we see Jesus for what he really is. We should guard against becoming familiar with the gospel and Jesus himself such that we just see him from a human point of view at the expense of seeing him from the divine perspective as well (vv.1-3a). If we do, we may find ourselves taking offence at Jesus (v.3b). And if that remains unchecked, we will be prejudiced against him and miss the spiritual benefits that come with believing Jesus for who he really is (vv.5-6). This will be deprived of the joy of our salvation and of serving him in faith and total dependence on the Holy Spirit's power at work in us. How you view Jesus determines how you respond to his teachings and serve him.
